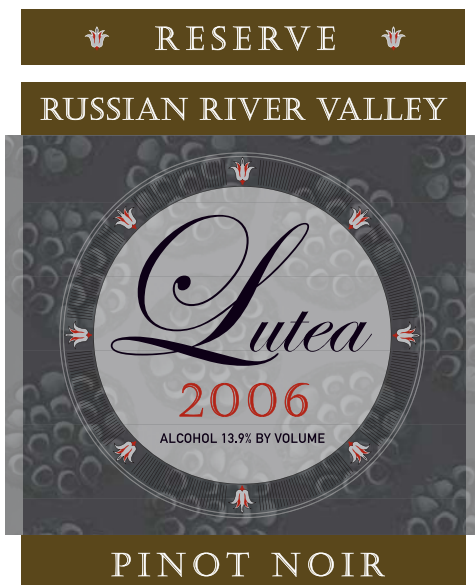

Lutea produces fine pinot noir from organically grown grapes in California's cool north coast region. We believe that organic viticulture practices yield higher quality fruit, while caring for worker health and the environment. This wine was made in the traditional way; the grapes were sorted, destemmed, cold soaked, punched down by hand, then gently pressed using a basket press. It was aged in French oak barrels for 15 months and was not fined or filtered.

Chosen as our two best barrels of Russian River Valley, our first reserve wine has serious structure. Deep ruby in color with a meaty nose of earth and forest floor. Black plum and macerated cherry flavors have bright acidity while moderate tannins provide structure and length. Decant.
